It satisfied the goal of the Association to finally bring us together as alumni rather than just classmates from each senior year. It truly established the association as a viable, vibrant and effective organization.

In the rear salon, classmates were able to browse memorabilia and inspect many items up in the silent auction. Many wonderful items were donated to the silent auction including wine, paintings, glassware, candles, tapestries, autographed guitar by Willie Nelson, needle point and quilted items. Included were many donated items from celebrities to be auctioned off. The auction stayed open until 10PM when the winning bids were announced.

Meanwhile a mouthwatering buffet was served with a devastatingly rich assortment of desserts. The dinner menu included tossed greens with water chestnuts, bamboo shoots and sesame seeds and tortellini pasta filled with ricotta cheese along with a tomato basil salad. The entrees included beef tenderloin with cabernet sauce, inside round of beef, and seared chicken breasts in an herb sauce. Veggies included red skinned garlic mashed potatoes, asparagus and carrots. Desserts followed with an assortment of delectable and decadent pies, cakes and torts. Needless to say, everyone's palette and appetite was satisfied with such a wonderful meal.

A raffle and dancing followed until 2am and then many alumni made their way to the Presidential Suite until 4AM where they continued their visiting and fellowship.
